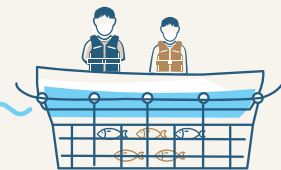

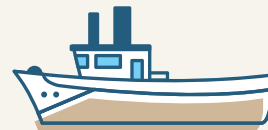
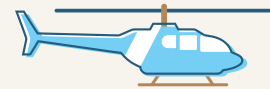

Designated Fishery Guardian Training Courses*

- **First Aid:** Basic First Aid, Advanced First Aid
- **Workplace Safety:** Personal Defensive Tactics, Tactical Positioning, Fitness (Self Defense, Small Firearms Safety and Practice), Swiftwater Rescue, Bear Awareness, Vessel, Shotgun, Global Positioning System (GPS) Devices, Safety Policies and Procedures
- **Rules and Regulations:** Fisheries and Environment Acts and Regulations (BC), Habitat Management, Fisheries Act, Fishery (General) Regulations, Licensing, Indigenous Laws and Regulations
- **Enforcement Authority:** Fishery Guardian Authorities (Observe, Record, Report), Checking Licences, Seizure of Small Items Procedures, Enforcement, Legal and Investigative Procedures, Advanced Investigative Procedures, Natural Resource Forensic Investigations, Special Investigations: Forensics and Habitat Prosecutions, Special Investigations: Habitat and Pollution Prosecutions, Compliance and Enforcement
- **Fish and Shellfish Biology:** Fish Identification, Biology (Salmonids, Fishes, Shellfish)
- **Monitoring and Data Collection:** Compliance Communications and Resource Monitoring, Fish and Fish Habitat Monitoring Skills, Land Monitoring Skills, Construction Site Monitoring Skills, Water Monitoring Skills, Environmental Monitoring, Habitat Assessment Methods, Monitoring Activities Near Water, Note-taking and Reporting, Collecting and Handling Evidence, Applied Stewardship Skills
- **Community Engagement and Education:** Communal Fishing, Effective Communication/Presentation Skills, Tactical Communications, Interpersonal Communications and Leadership Skills Development
- **Joint Patrols:** Aviation Egress
- **Testifying:** Court and Administrative Procedures, Preparing and Presenting Evidence in Court
