Fish Harvester Training Courses*

- **First Aid:** Standard (Level 1), Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (Level C), Automated External Defibrillation, Marine Basic, Marine Advanced Marine Emergency Duties
- **Fisheries-specific Rules and Regulations:** National Online Licensing System, Licence Conditions, Electronic Logbook
- **Marine Emergency Duties:** Levels A1, A2 or A3, Domestic Vessel Safety, Small Domestic Vessel Basic Safety
- **Equipment Set-up and Operation:** Deckhand Skills Training, Fishing Gear Construction and Maintenance, Small Engine Repair and Maintenance, Basic Netmaking and Repair, S.C.U.B.A. Diving Certification
- **Fish Handling:** Quality Fish Handling
- **Vessel Operations:** Radiotelephone Operator Certificate (Marine, Maritime Commercial), Small Vessel Operator Proficiency, Simulated Electronic Navigation (Limited Watchkeeping Mate of a Fishing Vessel), Fishing Vessel Safety Programs, Fishing Vessel Stability, Fishing Vessel Maintenance
- **Vessel Management:** Fishing Master (Class III, Class IV), Vessel Management
- **Knowledge Transfer:** At-sea Mentoring (Vessel Operator, Deckhand, Fishing Operations)
