We're losing OUR RESOURCES

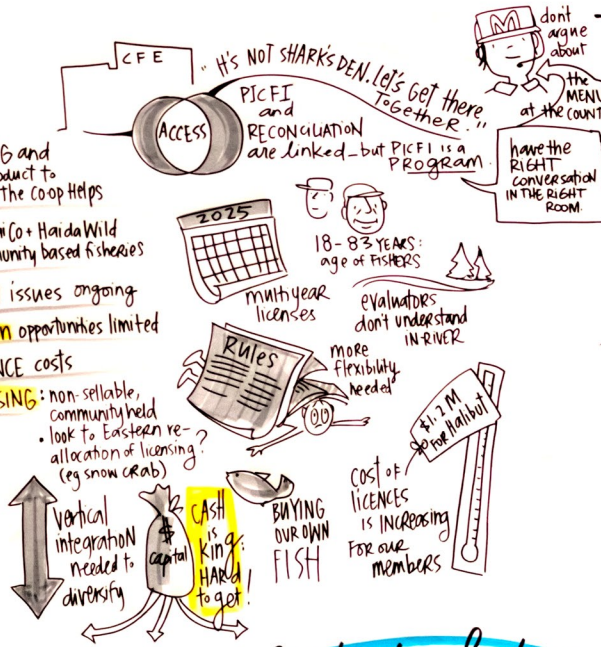
FISHING ENTERPRISES AND ISSUES:

INCLUDING:

- Buying boats because we NEED licenses - inhibits us
- Collaborating with other nations to achieve goals, including Co-ops
- We don't pay unfair "market prices" to fishers
- analyzing what the COMMUNITY makes not just individual businesses
- We have great trainings-but people can't fish after
- CFE helps with marketing, HUBS
- VALUE-ADDING and getting the product to market -> The Coop Helps
- Ec Dev like Haida Co + Haida Wild support community based fisheries
- ALLOCATION issues ongoing
- DIVERSIFICATION opportunities limited
- MAINTENANCE costs
- FIX LICENSING: non-sellable, community held
